See what love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God; and that is what we are. The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him. Beloved, we are God's children now; what we will be has not yet been revealed. What we do know is this: when he is revealed, we will be like him, for we will see him as he is. And all who have this hope in him purify themselves, just as he is pure.

1 John 3:1-3

Dear United In Christ,

It feels like a sort of audacious title to ascribe to us, doesn't it? *Children of God*? It feels pretty bold to claim ourselves as children of the Divine. To consider that the fullness of God's goodness – to say that God's majesty – is somehow a part of who *we* are? To claim that the one who reared the cosmos is also *our* paternal lineage? I mean, how does that even work? Who in their right mind would be so bold as to claim such a holy and sacred bloodline?

Because look around: it doesn't often feel like we do such a great job of treating one another as children of God, does it? Like, listen: I know the ways in which, by the things I have done and the things I have left undone, I have harmed those around me. I know the ways in which I have fallen short of the goodness God calls us to. To claim that I – with all of my errors and miscalculated ways – get to call myself a child of God can at times feel hypocritical. At the very least, it feels like I'm getting a little too big for my britches! But it's not just me, is it? Pick up any news source right now and you're sure to find all sorts of new and creative ways in which we manage to harm one

another. Escalating violence among nations, hyper-partisan divisiveness here at home, the dehumanization of those who don't act, think, love, speak, look, or identify the same as "us." Is this really the best that those claiming to be the "children of God" can do? Is the best that we can do *for* those named as "children of God" around us?

Looking around, it may start to feel like we are anything but this title. It certainly feels like it's not one we've earned for ourselves in any laudatory fashion! But I suppose this is precisely why it's probably a good reason that this definition *isn't* left up to us. The ascription of being named as children of God, it's not a title we've created for ourselves; it's the one that's been gifted by the very God who claims us – the God who claims *you*. In this month when we give thanks for all of the saints who have gone before us in the faith, we remember the faithfulness of God who makes this definition clear. We remember that just as God claimed each before us in the waters of baptism, so too does continue to claim us as part of God's ever growing kin-dom.

We remember that it *is* a rather bold endeavor that we should be called children of God; *and* (thanks be to God) that *is* what we are.




