

# FROM THE PASTOR



In those days Mary set out and went with haste to a Judean town in the hill country, where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the child leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and exclaimed with a loud cry, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And why has this happened to me, that the mother of my Lord comes to me? For as soon as I heard the sound of your greeting, the child in my womb leaped for joy. And blessed is she who believed that there would be a fulfillment of what was spoken to her by the Lord."

Luke 1:39-45

#### Dear United In Christ,

Everyone deserves to have an Elizabeth in their life, don't you think? Everyone should be able to have someone to whom they are able to turn in their moments of overwhelming emotion and feeling – someone whom they can call upon to share in their joy and only let that joy be compounded in the sharing! Truly, it's a sacred sort of connection that is held between Elizabeth and Mary in this mid-Advent text of ours. Still working through the implications of this new thing taking place within and around her, we find Mary now living into those implications as she meets with Zechariah and Elizabeth. No sooner is she able to share a word of greeting than it seems that Elizabeth is already bursting with joy and celebration at what is taking place. She celebrates what is at work in and through Mary as the two share in a sacred space of joy and wonder at God's work!

So, who is it for you? Who do you turn to? When you find yourself reeling in wonder, who do you call upon to make your joy complete? Who do you call upon to make your joy *overflow?* Is it a partner? A child? A parent? A friend? A cousin? When you have something that you just can't contain, who is it you turn to help you share in the compounded state of excitement and anticipation? Who is it that you are able to look towards in order to share in sacred joy together?

My hope in the weeks ahead is that, in the anticipated arrival of this Savior making his way into our world this season, you may find new cause for a joy worth sharing! May you find the hope of God's accompaniment claiming you in this Word now stepping into God's creation. May you find God's delight tucked into the company kept around you. As we journey in hope and anticipation towards the promises of Christmas, may your joy be made complete. May it be so filled to the brim that it must be shared.

This is the whole point of Christmas' fruition after all: God's life is arriving in this world and *that* is a joy worth sharing.

This is why, as communities of faith gather, we will honor "Blue Christmas" this year as a service of acknowledgement and a



# HOW DO YOU USE your perfect gift?

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God. -Ephesians 2:8a

True confessions: I've never worn the jaunty Christmas tie my son bought me five years ago. It's a waste, I know. At the end of every December I shake my head and say, well, maybe next year.

We ought to make good use of our gifts, but most of us have a few Christmas presents, given and received in love, that are forlornly collecting dust in a drawer or closet. That's not very good stewardship.

More important than a bottle of perfume or a loud tie, how are you stewarding that most precious of all Christmas gifts—the new life you have through faith in Jesus? Do you cherish it, honor it, make the most of all it has to offer? Because it is truly amazing.

New life. Too many Christians focus exclusively on the AFTER-life that begins when we die. But that's missing out on the joy, peace and fulfillment that Jesus promises us today, what he describes as life abundant. You've doubtless seen evidence of this life in the cheerful eyes and peaceful smiles of holy people you've encountered. Light seems to radiate from them.

I want that life. Don't you?

The abundant life is Jesus' free gift, but it doesn't come automatically. It grows with us as we grow in faith through prayer,

scripture study, worship, service and generosity – the disciplines of faith. In doing so, we align our hearts and souls with God's purposes and fulfill ever more closely those two holy commandments to love God and neighbor.

This year, don't let your faith end up like a jaunty Christmas tie, hanging unused in the closet. Make the most of it and live into the new, abundant life Jesus promises to us all. It's the number one stewardship lesson.
