

FROM THE PASTOR

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.

Philippians 4: 4-9

Dear United in Christ,

If you're anything like me, you find that new beginnings are both exciting and incredibly nerve-wracking! There is a deep sense of joy for all the things to come and an anxiety of the unknown. This is a passage of scripture I find myself repeatedly turning to, especially in times of change and newness. I remember one the first times I meaningfully engaged with these verses. It was my first summer as a counselor and I was working with my second cabin of middle school students. My campers were not connecting, some were desperately missing home, they were snippy with me and with each other and I felt by Tuesday morning that the week was a complete disaster! All I wanted to do was crawl under the table and hide—it felt impossible to

rejoice in the midst of how stressed I was. At lunch, I had a note on my seat that held these verses and a message of encouragement and a reminder to pause for prayer from Pastor Mary, one of the program directors. I took her note to heart and found my own attitude changed! My nerves didn't go away but the opportunities to rejoice were too many to ignore! And I am glad to say that I was wrong, the week ended up being a wonderful experience for the campers and their counselor.

"God's peace, which transcends all understanding" will be with you. Prayer offers us a chance to slow down, reflect, and take a moment to connect with God. Knowing that Paul's reminder to "rejoice in the Lord always" is not meant to fake joy in the face of difficulties but to trust that God is the one that is in control and carrying us—Paul certainly was not faking joy when he was writing these words from prison. Rejoice, taking comfort in God's all-encompassing peace and taking heart in the knowledge that Christ is near, even in times of great disappointment, unexpected experiences, and new and exciting ventures.

UIC, there is much for us to rejoice! You have offered so much love and support, embodying God's peace, and I am beyond grateful. I am so excited for the road ahead as the Spirit guides so we can share whatever is true and lovely and praiseworthy with the whole of God's people. Rejoice in the Lord always! Rejoice!

On Pentecost Sunday we will also be baptizing Kyle and Johanna Swanger's new baby, Walker, and confirming their other son, Kamden.


