### FROM THE PASTOR



When the entire nation had finished crossing over the Jordan, the LORD said to Joshua: "Select twelve men from the people, one from each tribe, and command them, 'Take twelve stones from here out of the middle of the Jordan, from the place where the priests' feet stood, carry them over with you, and lay them down in the place where you camp tonight.'" Then Joshua summoned the twelve men from the Israelites, whom he had appointed, one from each tribe. Joshua said to them, "Pass on before the ark of the LORD your God into the middle of the Jordan, and each of you take up a stone on his shoulder, one for each of the tribes of the Israelites, so that this may be a sign among you. When your children ask in time to come, 'What do those stones mean to you?' then you shall tell them that the waters of the Jordan were cut off in front of the ark of the covenant of the LORD. When it crossed over the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. So these stones shall be to the Israelites a memorial forever."

Dear United In Christ,

A lot of times it really feels like the Steve Miller Band had it right: "time keeps on slippin' (slippin' slippin') into the future."

In the rhythm of the year, June has always felt like one of the moments when that point is driven home most pointedly. Wrapping up another program and school year, the transitions that lay ahead through the summer months are a reminder that time moves ever onward like an ever-rolling stream. Our seniors gear up for the events of graduation with all of its celebrations. Students prepare for the move up to the next grade with new teachers and new subjects and new buildings. Some of us will prepare to shift gears at work or around the house. We camp, we travel, we seize opportunities for rest and renewal.

In more ways than one, this month marks the beginning of a season that we know can be somewhat fleeting. I'd be willing to

bet that, for many of us, there is a deep yearning to just be able to pause here — to let time freeze for the time being before it keeps on slippin' (slippin' slippin'). Come August and September, we may find ourselves wishing we could go back and relish those days when the weeks ahead held infinite possibility, before the clock started ticking away to new norms and rhythms and patterns once again.

Which is why I think it's a helpful reminder to us, in this community of faith, that time has *never* stood still for God's people. Always, God has moved the communities of God's beloved into the next steps of their shared future. Yet, God's encouragement comes with a certain recognition: God finds ways to mark out and remember the journey taken together. It's what's on display in this reading from Joshua; as God continues to lead the people ever onward from their exodus from Egypt towards the promised land, God affords the opportunity to remember the fullness of their journey. With a physical marker they place the memory of where they have been in order to remember their story when next they pass. There is no permanent stop, no halting in this place, but rather the marker of where they have been as they push forward to where God is calling them next.

In this month of transition, UIC, may you also find the course for such remembering. May you celebrate and give thanks for all that is worth lifting up. May you tell the stories of where you have been and the journeys you have made. May you share in the joy of culminating experiences and courses brought to fruition. May your memories be a continued blessing for whatever course that waits around the corner. And when the clock ticks onward, may you be grounded in the God who journeys with us yet ahead.


